A preanesthetic screening ECG is another helpful diagnostic to assure your pets' health prior to their procedure. ECG is used to assess cardiac conduction, meaning it checks the electrical message that goes through the heart in a specific manner so that it functions/pumps appropriately. Some arrhythmias (inappropriate rhythm/beats) can be detected by heart auscultation during physical exam, but some arrhythmias are subtle or not consistently present. An offsite cardiologist will assess the ECG prior to the procedure and if there are any abnormalities, they will recommend drug usage and if further diagnostics are warranted prior to the procedure.
